Introduction to Digital Thumbs Up

The A428 have digitalised the 'Thumbs Up' procedure and are trialling the new technology.

Digital Thumbs Up provides -

- Visual assurance that the machine Operative has seen you.
- Assurance that machine controls are isolated.
- Ensures that a machine is safe to pass or approach by providing the approaching person with clear visual and audible instructions, and acceptance from the Operator.

Remember the re-fuelling basics

- All refuelling must take place >10m from water
- At least 2M clearance between Tanker and Plant
- Never place yourself between a solid and moving object (including two moving objects)
- Always ensure that vehicles and plant are in a safe state before approaching
