GALLIFORD TRY | A303 | BINNY BIN– 23/02/2022

### Introduction

The BinnyBin is a disposal sanitary bin, removing the need for traditional sanitary bin waste suppliers. Sanitary waste is classed as 'offensive waste' not hazardous, medial or clinal, therefore allowing low levels of sanitary bin waste to be able to enter the black bin waste stream. The BinnyBin is locally managed by contracts, allowing for a cleaner toilet environment. It's Biomaster coating is proven to kill harmful bacteria. The BinnyBin also features a healthcare message from Jo's Trust encouraging employees to have their smear test to reduce the chance of cervical cancer.



#### Overview

- Assembled at site Length 31cm Width 17.5cm and Height 35.5cm allowing for more room around the toilet.
- Can take up to 7KG of sanitary waste
- Blocks odour
- Waterproof
- Fully compliant with HSE, EA and DOH
- Removes the need to visitors and sanitary contractors to site
- Environmentally responsible



#### Challenges

- You must order through the official website to ensure quality of product
- Onsite team must manage the level of waste
- Good communication is essential to understand who removes and constructs the next BinnyBin.





## Action Taken

- Female health and hygiene being championed in a male dominant industry
- Better toilet space for users
- No smell complaints
- Aesthetically more pleasing
- Important health messages being discussed

## Lessons Learnt

- Often when depots are being planned and installed, female health sanitation isn't usually discussed and can be uncomfortable for some. The BinnyBin allows for local management of sanitary waste and provides a cleaner and more pleasant toilet environment for female employees.
