Covid-19 Toolkit

Brief description of Initiative	Tarmac have introduced Covid-19 control measures at site entrances and exits to minimise the spread of the disease as far as possible within closures. These have been particularly effective on multidisciplinary schemes where Tarmac are responsible for the effective management of external contractors delivering necessary works on the Strategic Road Network. By strategically positioning a modified, manned welfare bus (see pictures below) at either end of the site, any person accessing or leaving the closure must adhere to the strict hand washing rules. All necessary equipment for effective hand washing is provided. The operative 'manning' the bus ensures that the supplies of sanitizer are regularly topped up, as well as supervising the site to ensure social distancing is enforced as practically as possible. The wash facilities are accompanied by general guidance as to how to proceed if you suspect you have any of the Coronavirus symptoms listed. Under no circumstances will anyone arriving on site with the symptoms be allowed further access. Tarmac have also enhanced the PPE provided to operatives to ensure the risk of receiving or transmitting the disease is reduced

What benefits have been realised?	Engagement with and adherence of hand washing is no longer considered an optional formality, it is understood that this a rule for gaining access on to site, regardless of the company you work for.
