## Euromark Contracting - Ankle Injury

**Date:** 16 December 2014

**Time:** 10:10 hrs

**Division:** Euromark Contracting

**Location:** A82 Dalrigh to Tyndrum

A Euromark Operative was working on the back of a stationary feeder vehicle which was parked in a layby on the A82 Dalrigh to Tyndrum road in Scotland when he stood on a wooden pallet used to store bags of thermoplastic. As the pallet collapsed, his foot became trapped causing him to fall and sustain a twist/sprain to his ankle which resulted in him being off work for over seven days. The IP continued to work the rest of the day, only reporting the incident upon his return to the Airdrie depot yard at 16:15. This delayed reporting is in breach of the group incident reporting procedure which requires all incidents to be reported immediately. A full investigation is currently underway by the Euromark Division.
