# **Greater Communication:**

- Email notifications from Airsweb are clearer and more concise, containing full details of the event and a link directly to the incident.
- "What happens after I enter an incident?" If you enter your email address in the Person Reporting section, Airsweb will send you an email highlighting the investigation findings and actions that your report has driven.
- Instant access to the latest Airsweb User Guides via the "3 Dot Menu" on the homepage.
