Safety Alert Further updates to our incident Reporting System - Airsweb

6 August 2019

In April we alerted you of the first stage of updates applied to Airsweb, following your feedback. We are now delighted to inform you of the next stage of enhancements to the system. The initial enhancements were focused on improvements for the user. This phase of enhancements are focused on improving reporting and analytics.



Improved Accuracy:

- New mandatory fields to ensure we are consistently capturing the data we need for improved analysis.
- All Airsweb User accounts for Supply Chain colleagues linked to their Organisation for improved accuracy in the data we collect.
- Mandatory 'Activity Field' to capture the contract type for Supply Chain and the activity being carried out for Highways England Employees:

- Traffic Officer
- RCC/ROC
- Working on the Strategic Road Network (SRN)
- Office based activity (Including home working and meetings)
- Attending a Training course
- Working away from Office (exc home working)
