HE Passport Steering Board Update: January 2020

Welcome to the first update from the HE Passport Steering Board this year.

As you might remember last year we agreed an extension with Mitie and Reference Point until the 31st January 2020; since then we have been working on the requirements of the scheme before moving to full implementation, but still need some work done; we are also working in partnership with Reference Point to understand other options the system can offer within scope.

To allow more time for the work is currently in progress, we have agreed a second extension, until the 30th April 2020.

Same conditions than previous agreement apply:

The agreement in place will ensure that those suppliers already signed up and engaged with the HE Passport scheme will have no additional costs to pay, for the duration of the agreed extension (3 months). For anyone who has not already signed up to the scheme, but wishes to do so, the cost will be £30 per person.

We have also agreed with Mitie that when we move to full implementation those that have signed up within this extension period will be valid for 12 months from the date of joining the scheme.

On the other hand, we continue developing the Highways Common Induction.

We are working hard to review content on 3rd party websites etc, to ensure that any dates or incorrect details around the HE Passport and HCI are removed and replaced with up to date information. If you come across anything that contradicts what is being released in these updates, please let us know and we can address this.
