

# Missing manhole cover - Injury to member of the public

# SafetyAlert

January 2016

## **Incident description:**

A vehicle broke down on the network and whilst awaiting recovery the occupants moved to an adjacent embankment for their safety. A member of the public stood on a raised manhole ring on the top of the embankment which was covered by timber boarding. The boarding gave way and the individual fell approximately 8 metres to the bottom of the chamber suffering serious potentially life changing injuries including multiple fractures.

#### Investigation/findings:

The manhole is owned by a 3<sup>rd</sup> party utility company. An investigation is ongoing and further information will follow.

### **Actions:**

- Service providers to be aware of 3<sup>rd</sup> party assets on the strategic road network
- Where undertaking maintenance work including grass cutting, litter picking etc. on verges and embankments ensure risk assessments and method statements (RAMS) include reference to any 3<sup>rd</sup> party assets and specific hazards
- Walk the site prior to commencing work activity to ensure all hazards have been identified in the RAMS
- Report any hazards immediately and make safe
- Brief all revelant staff on this incident
